[Precautions for Pool Use]

1. Please be sure to take a shower and wash all parts of your body thoroughly, and perform warm-up exercises before entering the pool. We prohibit swimming for those suspected of having infectious diseases, those who have been prohibited from swimming by a doctor or other authority, those who are intoxicated, or those who are not feeling well.
2. The wave pool gradually gets deeper toward the back, with the deepest part being 170cm. Please check the water depth display by the pool and swim in a depth that matches your height and swimming ability.
3. The poolside is slippery and dangerous, so absolutely do not run. Please walk carefully and watch your step.
4. When using rental play equipment, please be sure to check the usage precautions before using.
5. After swimming, be sure to wash your eyes, gargle, and wash all parts of your body thoroughly with a shower.
6. Please keep valuables in the designated valuables lockers inside the locker room.
7. Smoking is prohibited throughout the facility, including in locker rooms and restrooms.

[Request for Compliance with Prohibitions in the Pool]

8. Please do not enter the pool in clothing other than swimwear. (Swimwear material such as rash guards is permitted.)
9. Please do not bring items into the pool that could break or fall in and cause danger, such as towels, washcloths, sunglasses, diving masks, glass, or plastic products (excluding swimming goggles).
10. Bringing food and drinks into the pool and swimming while holding food or drinks (including gum and candy) in your mouth is prohibited.
11. We respect the cultural background and values of our guests and do not restrict use by guests

with tattoos. However, in the interest of ensuring all guests have a comfortable stay, we may refuse pool use if the facility determines that the tattoo may cause fear in other guests.

12. Please refrain from using suntan oil or sunscreen or swimming while wearing makeup.

13. The deepest part of the wave pool is dangerous, so please do not enter it. Also, the drainage and water inlet points are dangerous, so please do not touch them.

14. Please refrain from leaving unused floating devices inside the pool.

15. Diving and jumping into the pool are strictly prohibited in all areas as they are extremely dangerous. Diving while holding a swimming ring and boarding a boat from the poolside are also prohibited.

16. Submerging or pretending to drown is extremely dangerous and interferes with monitoring and rescue operations, so absolutely do not do this.

[Caution and Request for Guests with Children]

17. Since it is extremely dangerous for children to swim alone, please ensure that they are always accompanied by a guardian (adult) while swimming. Children in junior high school or younger are not permitted to enter without a guardian.

18. Guardians must not take their eyes off their children while in the facility, both inside and outside the pool. Pay particular attention when children are swimming with a swimming ring, especially when waves are running.

19. Children of elementary school age or younger are requested to wear a life jacket or helper vest.

20. Guardians should ensure the life jacket is the correct size for the child before assisting them in putting it on.

21. Please do not allow children to play on escalators or stairs.

22. When using the pool with small children, please ensure they wear swim diapers. Use of the pool while wearing only regular diapers is prohibited.

[Other Precautions and Requests]

23. Please follow the instructions of the lifeguards and staff while in the pool.

24. If an accident occurs or is discovered, please immediately inform the lifeguards or staff.
25. Please refrain from behavior that bothers other guests or violates public morals.
26. Please be aware that if you do not follow the instructions of the lifeguards or staff, you may be asked to leave the facility.
27. Please use the facility in a way that matches your physical condition and stamina.
28. We are not responsible for accidents or theft caused by the negligence of guests.
